School Camp 2018

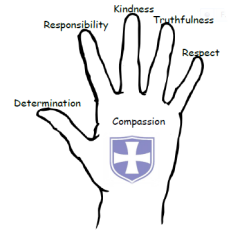

FREE COURSE FOR PARENTS AND CARERS OF CHALLENGING TEENAGERS [Y6 OR ABOVE]

A free course for parents and carers entitled "Take 3 – Support for Parents and Carers of Challenging Teenagers" is taking place at Helston Community College from 12th January 2018. If parents/carers have worries about a child in Y6 or above, or would just like to understand their child better, this course will have something for them. An informal and friendly course, run over 10 sessions, which covers: Putting in rules and boundaries that work, Encouraging and supporting young people, Helping parents look after themselves.
