Stories with Familiar Settings

We will be reading stories with familiar settings, such as My Fantastic Family! Five Minutes Peace and the series of Alfie books by Shirley Hughes. During this time we will study the story 'The Tiger Who Came To Tea' over 3 weeks, using the Talk for Writing method.



Labels, Lists, Signs and Posters

There will be lots of drawing, sign making and poster creating as we set up the classroom together.

Daily Read Write Inc

These are known as our daily Phonics sessions where the children learn about the different letter sounds.

Weekly Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar

Our main focus will be embedding the basics; letter formation, capital letters, clear finger spaces and full stops.

Religious Education

Creation (Autumn 1)

Who made the World? is the question we will be posing to the children this term. We will be looking closely at what a Creator does and linking this to the Christian belief that God created the Universe. The children will study the Story of Creation and look at how we should continue to care for God's greatest creation.

Incarnation (Autumn 2)

Why do Christians perform Nativity plays at Christmas? The children will explore this question as they practise for their own performance of the Nativity.



ICT

This Online Safety unit is aimed at teaching basic online safety and digital literacy skills. The children will learn about the potential dangers in the online world and what basic steps to take in order to have positive digital experiences and the children will develop the skills to recognise potential dangers and act accordingly to keep themselves and others safe. We will finish the term by learning how to use the software Paint; developing our hand eye coordination too.

Science

Amazing Me! (Autumn 1)

Over the course of the term we will be looking at how we have changed; the changes between being a baby to what we are like now. We will also be studying our Senses; sight, touch, hearing and smell.

To finish the Topic off and lead **nic:ye** into our D&T we will look into what makes a balanced diet, focusing on what's in our lunch boxes?

Weather Art (Autumn 2)

As the weather begins to change and the nights grow darker we will study the four seasons, investigate the wind; making a wind stock and look at light, which **leads** us into creating a Shadow Theatre.

Physical Education

Mathematics: Number and Place Value

To begin with we will be building the children's confidence with Numbers and their Place Value, ensuring everyone can read, write (in number and word form) each number and count out given quantities.
EYFS - Numbers to 10 **Y1 - Numbers to 50** **Y2 - Numbers to 100**

Year 1 and 2 children will be extended by looking at partitioning numbers and learning their number bonds.

Once the children have gained a secure understanding of these numbers we will begin to add and subtract, applying the number facts they have learnt.

This knowledge will support the children as they explore fractions (doubles and halves), understanding odd and even numbers.

We will all join together in exploring the world of measures this term as well.

Topic: Kings and Queens and The Gun Powder

Plot

For this Topic this term, we start by focusing on ourselves by looking at our family by painting family portraits, family trees and looking at our local area. We will then focus on current and past Kings and Queens and then we will study the famous event of The Gun Powder Plot through a range of activities.



Design Technology: Royal Tea Party

As we will be looking closely at the Royal Family and the Kings and Queens of the past we thought it would be a great way to end the term. The children will design, create, make and bake everything needed for a Tea Party fit for a Queen.
