All children who read at home 4 times a week will be given a stamp in their Passport when they have 10 stamps they get to choose a book to keep.

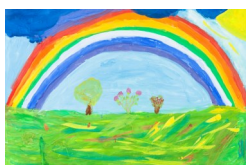
All the children have been given reading targets.

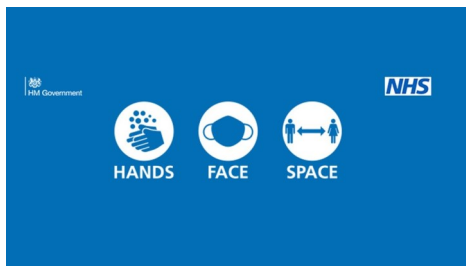


New National Lockdown
