SEA SWIMMING LESSONS

I am looking at holding Sea swimming lessons for children and adults at Kennack Sands Beach through the school holidays!

I am a qualified swimming teacher and coach and I will be running children and adult sea swim lessons through July/ August.

Children need to be able to swim a little, (doggy paddle is fine) as these sessions are designed to show the swimmers the difference between swimming in a pool and the sea. They will learn survival skills, lifeguard rules and how to spot a rip current/ choosing a safe place to take a swim.

Sessions are 30mins and are £6 a child. They need : Wetsuit and Beach Shoes (This is essential as the sea temperature is significantly lower than the average pool and with the weather heating up it also increases the risks of treading on a weaver fish in the sand)

Adults don't need to come in the sea for the lessons but they will need to be on the beach and in the designated area to make it easy to spot if their child should need something and for collection at the end of the lessons.
