Slapped Cheek

It has come to our attention that Slapped Cheek is doing the rounds on The Lizard! Slapped cheek syndrome (also known as parvovirus virus) usually causes a bright red rash on the cheeks. Although the rash can look alarming, slapped cheek syndrome is normally a mild infection that clears up by itself in one to three weeks. Once you've had the infection, you're usually immune to it for life. However, slapped cheek syndrome is more serious for some people – especially if you are pregnant, have a blood disorder or a weakened immune system. If you suspect your child may have slapped cheek please could you seek medical advice from you GP as soon as possible and inform the school. Thank you very much for your help and understanding.
