

English

The children will be listening to the sounds of the sea and writing a powerful poem about the sea. The children will also be creating persuasive poster to save our seas from plastic. Using the wonderful *Sand Horse* (Michael Foreman) children learn the story, retell it, use role play and then create their own version Using the book, *Dear Greenpeace* the children will learn the format of writing a letter or postcard. Children use labels, lists, signs and posters to write about sea creatures and *The Lonely Sea Monster*. They write about their own imaginary creatures and undersea worlds.

Daily Read Write Inc

These are known as our daily Phonics sessions where the children learn about the different letter sounds.

Weekly Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar

Our main focus will be embedding the basics; letter formation, Capital letters, clear finger spaces and full stops.

Religious Education

Learning from religion and about religion.

Asking :Why does Easter matter to Christians ? Consider that Salvation is part of the big story of the Bible. Learning about Judaism, finding out about a Jewish way of life, traditions, celebrations and places of worship.



ICT

Our computing learning will be about developing our individual skills, such as being able to drag or clip using a mouse or a track pad, being confident to switch on and shut down a computer independently. We will learn the skills needed to launch an application by double clicking, be able to save our work to folders independently. We will continue to learn about the need for online safety at all times.

Science

Art and nature:

Children will investigate and sort materials according to where they came from and also learn all about those materials that come from plants. They will also create a large pollen sculptures out of clay, find flowers outside in the playground and sketch them and then make a large model of the inside of a flower using junk modelling materials! Now the weather is getting better the children will enjoy being outside by doing bark and leaf rubbings and then do a piece of playground art, using cloths, chalk and found materials.
