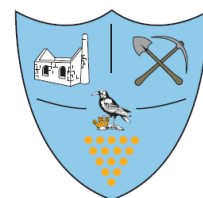

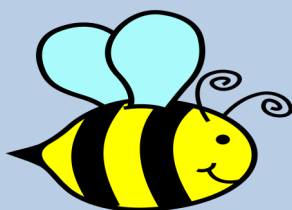
*Message from Miss Furnish*

Rachel, a family worker, will also be available to offer any advice you would like on areas such as coping with challenging behaviour, toileting or bedtime routines. All welcome!!!!

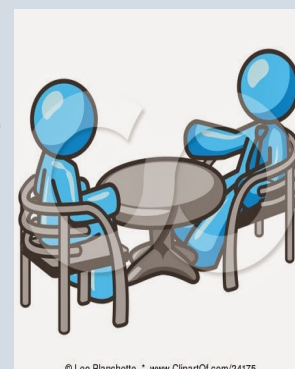
