5 minutes late every day = 3 days of school lost each year

10 minutes late = 6 days lost

15 minutes late = 10 days lost



Reminders

Children's safety: Please do not walk children through the car park as this puts them at risk.

Breakfast Club: This operates from 8:00 a.m., please do not send children before 8 a.m. as the staff are unable to look after them as they require the time to set up. The cost of £1.20 per child should be paid to the staff on the morning the children attend or at the start of the week.

Picking up children: Please ensure that you let the class teacher know if someone else is picking up your child. If there is a change of arrangements during the day, please telephone the office to inform however, please note we can only take instructions from the parent/carer of the child.

Jewellery/Tatoos/Nail varnish/Fake Nails: As you are aware, our policy regarding jewellery is that children can only wear small stud earrings and a watch if they want to, no necklaces/bracelets/rings etc. are allowed. Please do not send your child to school with transfer tattoos on their skin or nail varnish/fake nails.
