- Your child tests positive for COVID-19, having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being at school.
- Your child tests positive within 48 hours of being at school but has no symptoms.

If your child tests positive for Coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, you will not need to contact the school. You should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

## ASYMPTOMATIC TESTING PROGRAMME

Following the success of the asymptomatic testing programme on the return to school, it is vital to keep testing at home throughout the Easter holidays and into the summer term:

- test twice a week at home from now on (all those who are able to)
- report results online as positive, negative or void. This information is critical in helping us to understand the prevalence of the virus across the country
- continue to test twice weekly over the Easter holidays
- test before returning to school for the summer term, either the night before, or morning of, the first day back, to find and isolate any positive cases.
