Dear Parents,

This term, we will be learning:

- Maths: Counting; place value; addition and subtraction
- Literacy: Stories with a repeating pattern
- History: What was life like for a Victorian child?
- Science: Materials Monster
- RE: Who is Muslim and how do they live?

Homework

Children will be given a different homework activity each night of the week.

Monday – Mathletics (online activities to be completed at home)

Tuesday – reading book (please listen to your child then talk about the book)

Wednesday – phoneme fans (practise saying the sounds)

Thursday – reading book

Friday – tricky words (practise reading AND spelling)

Whilst reading books will be sent home on Tuesday and Thursday, your child is welcome to take a book home every night if they wish.

Children should develop independent learning by carrying out tasks related to our topics. A list of possible tasks follows, although your child may choose to develop their learning with a task that is not suggested below. Children are expected to complete at least 1 homework task by the end of term.
