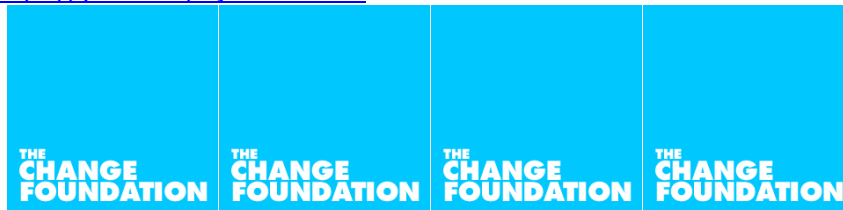

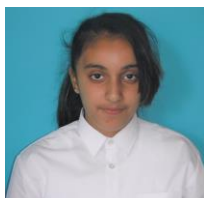
The club is completely FREE and will include a variety of inclusive sports and games with the aim of enabling the students to set goals through the power of sport.
