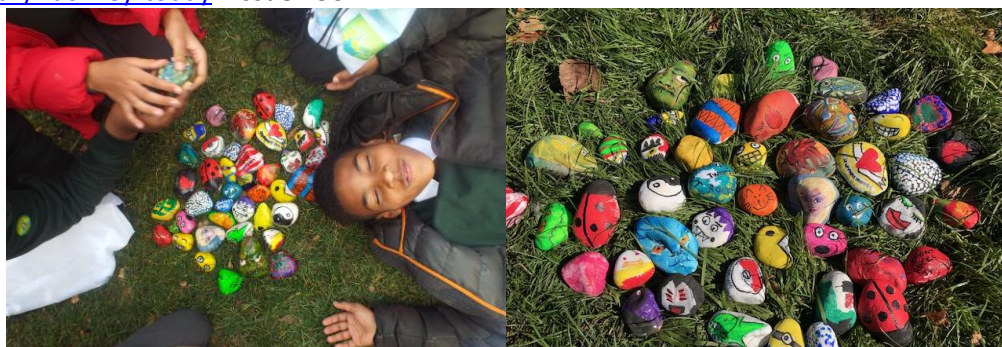

As a Young Producer you could:

- Learn to plan events for different audiences
- Gain experience in marketing and promotion, including social media
- Meet and work with other young people
- Collaborate across the museum's different teams
- Explore and share stories from the museum
- Work with arts and heritage professionals

What you need to know:

The group meets once every two weeks on a Tuesday evening between 5 - 7pm at the museum

Each Young Producers project lasts 4 - 6 months with an event at the end. You can stay for one project or more!

The museum will repay travel expenses up to £12.70 and provide snacks and drinks
