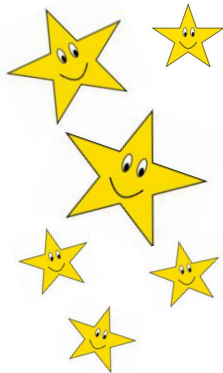

ParentPay

Making a payment to the school is straightforward and ParentPay holds an electronic record of your payments to view at a later date; no card details are stored in any part of the system and the school does not have access to this



information. Once you've activated your account you can make online payments straight away. Parents who are unable to make payments online, or wish to continue paying in cash, can request a PayPoint Card. This will enable you to pay at any store which displays the PayPoint sign. Please be aware that payments made via PayPoint can take up to three days to be credited to pupil accounts. Please inform the school if you require a PayPoint Card. **We aim to become a completely cash free office.** We now have an office iPad so we can help you to set up your account. If you need any help with using ParentPay or have any queries relating to payments, the office staff are more than happy to help you.
