## **Clarification about the beginning and end of the school day routines**

Below is clarification of how the children will come into school in the mornings and leave school at the end of the day. Due to the busy nature of the main road at the front of the school, no child will be allowed to leave the school grounds without an adult, unless the school have received prior notice that they: walk home, walk to meet parents in a car or walk to a nearby location.

Children will remain in the care of the adults until they are satisfied that they are safe to leave the school site.

### **Reception and KS1 Start of the day routines:**

All children will enter their classrooms through their outside school door (Years Reception, 1 and 2).

Staff on the door will be able to take short messages. Any longer conversations must be booked via the office for a separate time. The adults are on the door to keep the children safe.

The doors will shut at 9am and all children who are late will enter the school through the main reception.

### **KS2 Children start of the day routines:**

KS2 children will enter the school through the main entrance and will be met by their class teacher at their classroom door.

Mrs Rowe will take messages for the teachers at the reception. If you require a longer meeting with the class teacher, this can be booked through Mrs Rowe.

### **Reception and KS1 end of the day routines:**

Children will be dismissed from their classroom door.

They will only be dismissed to a known adult.

If children forget an item, they must wait for all of the children to leave before collecting it. This means the adult on the door remains vigilant and is able to ensure children get to their adult safely.

### **KS2 end of the day routines:**

Class teachers will escort their class onto the playground and dismiss the children once they have seen the child's adult.

Children whose adults are late or haven't arrived, will wait with the class teacher.

Only children whose parents have notified the school, will be allowed to walk home alone, or out of the school to meet a parent at the car.
