Temporary Entrance to the school site - First week back at School

The current entrance on Crawley Lane will be closed and pedestrians who used that access will now have to use the alleyway that currently leads to the Infant Academy and the Children and Family Centre. This is to keep pedestrians and vehicles (especially delivery lorries) separated in the car park. Access from either of the gates attached to the Infant Academy will not change.

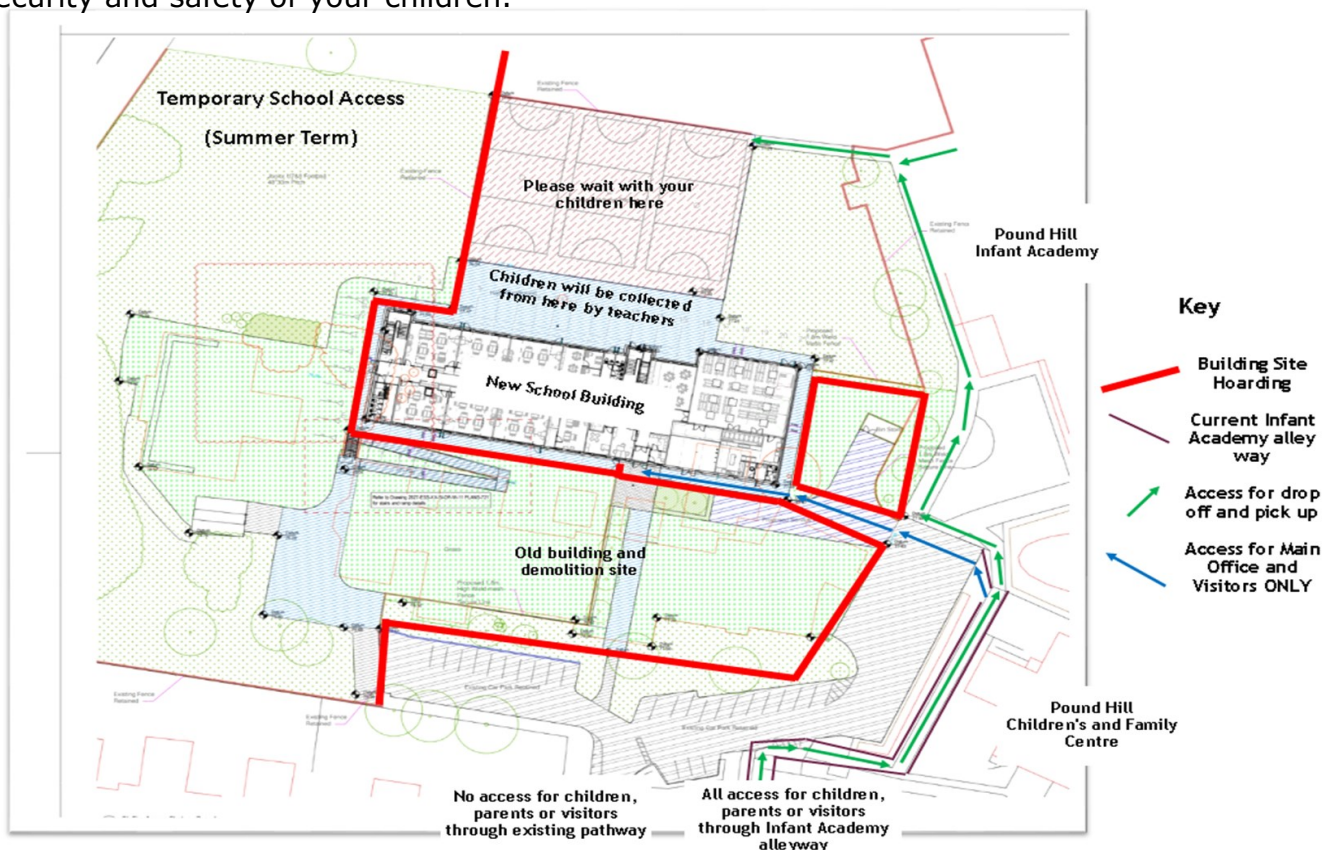
At drop off and at pick up times, please walk through the gate into the Infant Academy grounds, past their hall and then into our playground from the field end.

At the start of the day teachers will come to the playground, line up their class and bring them in at 8.30am

At the end of the day teachers will lead their class out to be released towards the far end of the playground.

This will be identical to how Years 3 and 4 arrive and leave school but it will be for all year groups.

If you need to visit the front office, you will need to return to the entrance gate for the Infant Academy and carefully cross the top of the carpark. Please enter via the front doors only and ring for attention. Unlike the current school, access to speak to a member of the front office will be through a set of security doors. Access to the school is controlled through another set of security doors. Please do not enter the school by any other door other than the front entrance to ensure security and safety of your children.
