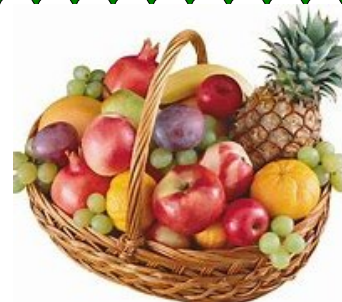


Fruity Friday
