

PE Guidelines for Parents

- Every child must have a PE kit consisting of a plain white top, plain black shorts and daps or trainers. Trainers must be able to fasten and not high tops. **NO** jewellery is to be worn for PE or swimming.

KS1 will be given spare kit with a follow up phone call to parents.

KS2 will have spare kit once, a second time will result in being sent to Miss Fitzpatrick to explain why they haven't got kit along with a phone call home.

- The PE behaviour flow chart will be followed, a copy of this is on the website in the Behaviour policy.
- Any children in KS1 who are unable to take part in PE will have a craft task to do, such as, making a medal or designing a sports kit.
- Any children in KS2 who are unable to take part in PE will need a note from parents explaining why. They will then be sent to a different classroom with work set by the class teacher.
- **BEST** scores are given for each lesson, the class in each year group with the highest average score will be class of the term and receive a reward the following term.

Behaviour: following instructions and expectations

Effort: How hard the children tried in each activity

Sportsmanship: Being honest, fair and playing by the rules

Teamwork: Working together, helping others, including everyone.
