Privacy notice - Data Protection Act 1998: how we use your information

We, North Somerset Council, collect and process information about children in our care and children to whom we provide services. We use this personal data to:

- support these children and monitor their progress
- provide them with pastoral care; and
- assess the quality of our services

This information includes personal characteristics and details for the services we provide.

We are required, by law, to pass on some of this information to the Department for Education (DfE) which uses it to; develop national policies, manage local authority performance, administer and allocate funding and identify and encourage good practice. Under certain conditions, DfE may share some of the information we provide to them with third parties (for example for the purpose of research). Any such sharing by DfE is strictly controlled and in compliance with the Data Protection Act 1998.

We are legally obliged to share information with other agencies (e.g, Police, Health, Schools) when there are safety concerns about children.
