Reception School Trip to Painshill Park, Cobham on Wednesday 23rd June

To leave Busbridge Infant School at 9.15am. To return to Busbridge Infant School by 2.45pm*

**please drop and pick your child up from school at the usual time*

As part of our topic on water we have organised a school trip for Reception to visit Painshill Park, Cobham. The children will be visiting for the day to go on a mini beast safari and a pirate story walk. This trip will link in with our learning about habitats and living things, as well as inspire our story telling.

With the Government providing free school meals for children at KS1, we will be offering a free packed lunch for your child on this trip, however you must indicate on the **online consent and lunch choice** form [here](#) that you would like us to do so. We have two menus from which to choose, Menu A and Menu B; please see the choice below. Please note that it is not possible to offer any alternatives to the menu below and that if a menu choice is not notified by **Wednesday 9th June** you will need to provide your child with a packed lunch. This is because the kitchen staff have to place their food order in advance of the trip.

All children will need a **named bottle of water** (and, if you have not opted for a school one, a packed lunch). Children should wear their **usual school uniform** on their **top half** (polo shirt, jumpers and cardigans), practical **long trousers/leggings/jogging bottoms** (not shorts or skirts), a suitable **waterproof coat** and appropriate **closed footwear** (trainers would be perfect). If it has been wet, wellies and a waterproof would be appropriate. Please apply sunscreen at home and bring a sunhat if sunny.

To cover the costs of this exciting experience, we are requesting a voluntary contribution of **£21.50 per child**. Please could you make the **payment online via SCOPay [here](#) by Wednesday 9 June**. However, do also feel free to contact the office in complete confidence if you anticipate any difficulties with the payment so that we can support you with this.
