Dear Parents and Carers,

Trip to the Beach – Tuesday 16th July 2019

As part of our Islands topic, we have organised a school trip for Year 1 to visit West Wittering on **Tuesday 16th July**. We will be explaining how we live on an island and how we are surrounded by the sea – looking at the Isle of Wight from Wittering beach. Other activities will include having a sea safety presentation from the local lifeguards, beach games, activities and art.

We will be having a packed lunch followed by an ice cream treat provided by teachers (allergies accounted for).

Sun cream is to be applied prior to arriving at school but children can **reapply their own** sun cream later if needed under the supervision of a teacher.

Children should wear clothing appropriate for the beach and the weather on the day. **School uniform is NOT required.** To help identify our children on the beach, they will be wearing our new Busbridge Infant School high vis jackets over their mufti – a big thanks to the PTA for providing these for us.



What the children need to bring:

- Water bottle (everyone) & lunch (if you are providing) in a named backpack
- Additional sun cream if necessary/desired and a sun hat
- A **NAMED** bucket and spade if you have one that you can bring it along and share it with those that don't.
- A raincoat (we have rain activities planned but may return to school earlier than originally stated).

Please note, we will NOT be going in the sea on this trip.

The coach will leave school at **9.15am promptly**. We expect to return at about 3.00pm but please note that this is an approximate time and is dependent on traffic conditions.

With the Government providing free school meals for children at KS1, we will be offering a free packed lunch for your child on this trip, however you must indicate on the enclosed consent form that you would like us to do so. **We have two menus from which to choose, Menu A and Menu B, please see the choice below. Please note that it is not possible to offer any alternatives to the menu below. If a menu choice is not notified by Tuesday 2nd July, you will need to provide your child with a packed lunch.**
