Wrens School Trip to Witley Common, Witley on Tuesday 18th June

To leave Busbridge Infant School at 9.15am. To return to Busbridge Infant School by 3.00pm*

As part of our topic on water we have organised a school trip for Reception to visit Witley Common, part of the National Trust. The children will be visiting the centre for the day to go on a nature walk, bug hunt, experience pond dipping and den building. This trip will link in with our learning about habitats and living things.

With the Government providing free school meals for children at KS1, we will be offering a free packed lunch for your child on this trip, however you must indicate on the consent form that you would like us to do so. **If a menu choice is not notified by Monday 10**th **June, you will need to provide your child with a packed lunch.** This is because the kitchen staff have to place their food order in advance of the trip.

All children will need a named bottle of water and a packed lunch (unless you have opted for the school packed lunch), and to wear a school polo shirt, sweatshirt and long trousers/jeans/leggings/jogging bottoms, (not shorts or skirts) and suitable closed in footwear (trainers would be perfect). If it has been wet, wellies and a waterproof would be appropriate. Please apply sunscreen at home and bring a sunhat if sunny.

The cost of the trip is £13.50 which includes transport and admission. This visit is classed as a voluntary activity under the Education Reform Act 1988 regulations. Children will not be excluded from the visit because parents are not in a position to contribute, but as we are not able to fund the activity in any other way it will be cancelled unless the costs are covered. We strongly believe in the educational value of these activities and we hope that you will support our efforts on your child's behalf. Please contact the office or your class teacher in complete confidence if you have any financial concerns. Please complete the permission form and return it to the school office and make your payment online via SCOpay.
