Newsletter 1 Summer Term



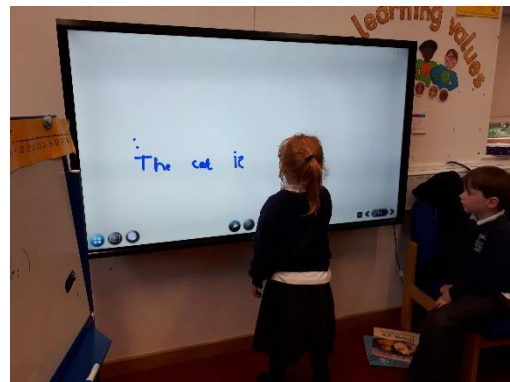
