## *Breakfast Club*

A number of years ago we ran a successful breakfast club at St Mary's but due to dwindling numbers, this had to close as it was not viable. Since then we have developed a successful relationship with childminders in the area who support working parents in 'wrap around care'; dropping children at school in the morning and providing care after school. We are currently considering the possibility of offering a breakfast club at school and carrying out research into the logistics of this. In order for this to go ahead we would like to gauge parent interest in this provision as we would require a number of attendees to cover outgoing costs including staffing and resources.

The Breakfast Club would run from 8am until the start of school. Children would have a healthy breakfast e.g. cereal, fruit, toast, fruit juice/milk and will be offered activities in the school hall or playground (weather permitting). The cost of the club is likely to be in the region of £3.50 but this could be subject to change.

Please indicate on the attached form or by email if you would consider using the breakfast club. Whilst this is not a binding commitment, it would be beneficial to gain accurate numbers, as the decision to start a club will be dependent on this. Should numbers decline the Breakfast Club would have to cease to operate.

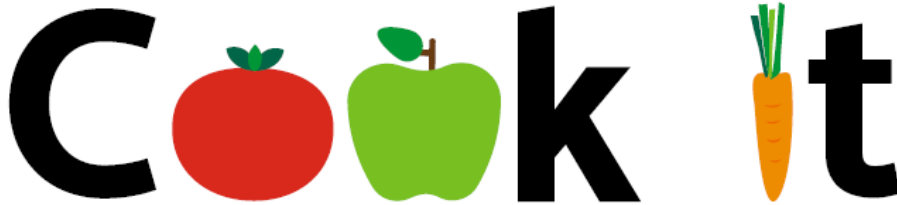
