## **Urgent Advice to Year 2 Parents**

### **Covid 19 'single case' at Oak Green School**

Dear Parents of 'close contacts' of Covid 19 – children in Year 2.

We have been advised by Public Health England that there has been a confirmed case of COVID-19 in **an adult in Year 2**. Upon the advice, this morning, of Public Health England, I am afraid, therefore that we have to

**advise that Year 2 children and adults self-isolate for 14 Days from the last contact.**

**Year 2 will be closed to the whole of Year 2 from Monday 14th-Wednesday 23rd September.**

**The school remains OPEN to Nursery, Reception, Year 1, Year 3, 4, 5 and 6. These children must continue to attend school as normal. We will keep this under review.**

**This does not mean that your child is unwell – only that they might have come into contact with a 'single case'.**

We have followed the national guidance and have identified that your child might have been in close contact with the affected person. In line with the national guidance we recommend that your child now stay at home and self-isolate until **a return on Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> September.** (14 days after the last potential contact with the member of staff).

We are asking you to do this to reduce the further spread of COVID 19 to others in the community. If your child is well at the end of these 14 days period of self-isolation, then they can return to usual activities. Other members of your household can continue normal activities provided your child does not develop symptoms within the 14 day self-isolation period. #### **What to do if your child does develop symptoms of COVID 19**

If your child develops symptoms of COVID-19, they should remain at home for at least 10 days from the date when their symptoms appeared. Anyone with symptoms will be eligible for testing and this can be arranged via <https://www.nhs.uk/ask-for-a-coronavirus-test> or by calling 119 . Then all other household members who remain well must stay at home and not leave the house for 14 days. The 14-day period starts from the day when the first person in the house became ill. Household members staying at home for 14 days will greatly reduce the overall amount of infection the household could pass on to others in the community. If you are able can, move any vulnerable individuals (such as the elderly and those with underlying health conditions) out of your home, to stay with friends or family for the duration of the home isolation period
