We would like to welcome you all to the first half term of our new academic year. We have lots of new children who are joining Jungle Nursery and children returning from last term. We hope all your children settle in very well and quickly with us.



This term we will be getting to know your children, finding out about all their interests and their ways of exploring. From these observations we will plan activities for each child to enhance and to help extend their learning.



Our topics this term will be 'All About me', 'Autumn', 'Festivals', 'Nursery Rhymes', 'Shapes & Colours' and 'Christmas'. We will look at each topic for 2 weeks before moving onto the next topic.

To help us support your child as they settle in, can we politely ask:

- For all your child's belongings to be clearly labelled with your child's name on to ensure they do not get misplaced.
- Please provide your child with a full set of spare clothing every day in case your child needs changing.
- Please ensure that your child has enough nappies, wipes and creams (if required) for the week ahead in their bag.
- Can you please take all jewellery off your child before they come into the Nursery to ensure no accidents happen and you child is safe.

This is in line with the school's policy.



We offer a healthy snack consisting of fruit and vegetables for each child during their session which will be accompanied by a choice of milk or water. If you would like to

bring in a named water bottle these can be kept in the room. This is to promote healthy eating and encourage children to try new/different things.

As a reminder, we are able to send you photos and observations of your child during their time at Nursery. This is completely optional. To do this we will need your email address for us to send them to you. If you have already completed the form included in your welcome pack you do not need to complete the form below.

We would also love for you to send us photos of your child doing any fun activity from anything they do at home.

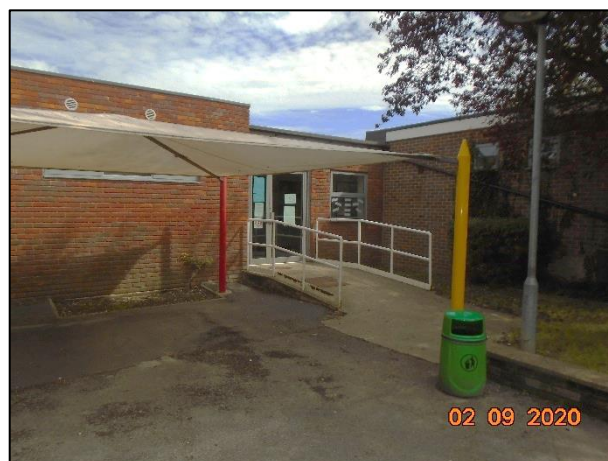

Any artwork or creations to be taken home will be put in your child's green pocket. These are located on the wall opposite the Jungle nursery door, and a photo of your child will be on the front of theirs. Please can you ensure you regularly check and empty your child's green pocket as it may quickly fill up.

We will also write reminder notices on the red framed whiteboard which can be seen as you walk in.

Keeping childing safe with COVID-19.

To help maintain social distancing there is a one-way system in place throughout the school. Jungle children will enter through the Rainbow entrance and exit through the Jungle door. To keep both you and your children safe, please check your child's temperature before coming into school.



Please enter via the Rainbow entrance (left) and leave by the Jungle door (right.)

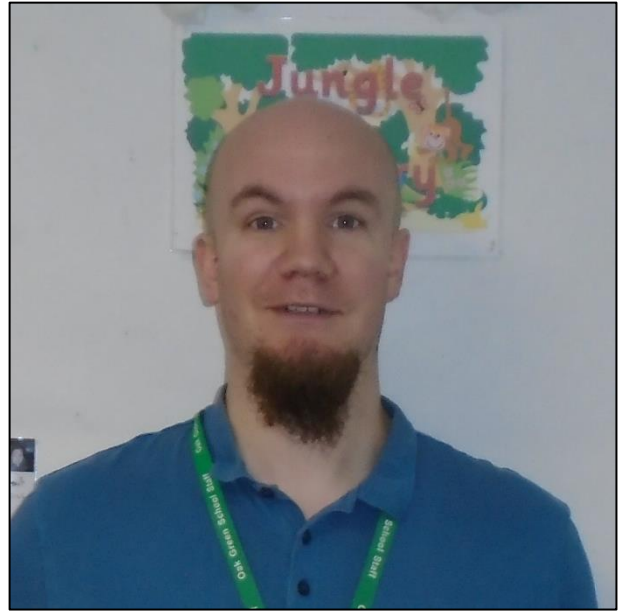
If your child or another member of your household has **any** of the following symptoms they must self-isolate for 14 days:

- A high temperature – feeling hot to touch on the chest or back
- A new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours. If your child usually has a cough, it may be worse than usual.
- A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.

We will be helping children to wash their hands throughout the session, and regularly cleaning and disinfecting toys and equipment.
