## What to do if a Child Discloses

Listen



Provide Support

Explain what will happen next

Decide if referral is needed

Reassure

Take it seriously

Record the conversation in the child's words

Sign and Date Records

### Don't.....

- ⇒ **Make promises that you cannot keep**
- ⇒ **Ask leading questions**
- ⇒ **Jump to conclusions**
- ⇒ **Speculate or make accusations**
- ⇒ **Display any disbelief**
- ⇒ **Never delay immediate response to protect a child**
- ⇒ **Act shocked or disgusted**
