New Topic for next half term – Sow, Grow and Farm

- In History, children will be learning about allotments in the United Kingdom and how the government encouraged people to have them to support food rationing during the Second World War.
- In Geography, they will learn about farming in the United Kingdom and the techniques used in modern farming, including the challenges that farmers face; the benefits of eating seasonally and about the pros and cons of importing food; world farming and how the different climate zones affect where different foods can be grown.
- In Science, they will be learning about food webs and animal life cycles, including how living things are dependent on one another within a habitat. The children will also learn how to investigate the different ways that plants reproduce and will dissect flowering plants to identify the different structures.
- In English, the children will read the book 'The Secret Garden' by Frances Hodgson Burnett. This book will inspire the children to write diary entries and create persuasive fair trade leaflets.
- In Design and Technology, the children will be grating, dicing and peeling seasonal vegetables to design and make healthy soups.
