Welcome to Holy Trinity School. As parents/guardians/teachers of children attending Holy Trinity School we are all automatically members of the PTFA.

Why?

The PTFA's aim is to help the school and our children primarily by providing additional resources outside the normal school budget while enhancing our children's education. At the same time we bring our whole school community together through fun social events.

What do we do?

Through our ongoing fundraising we assist the school annually with running the children's library service, making contributions to the Pupil's Bursary Fund and Year 6 leavers' hoodies. Each term £100 per class is available to purchase essential items needed in the classroom. We have also purchased new laptops, a yearly learning resource, Doodle Maths and English subscription for the whole school, football kits and playground sports equipment.



How do we raise funds?

Throughout the year the PTFA organise a variety of family supported events. These events include the Christmas Bazaar, Summer Fair, Children's Disco, Film Nights and our regular cake sales; ice-lollies are also on sale every Friday during the Summer term. Other events are Mother's and Father's day sales, pre-loved uniform sales and more.



Summer Fair

There are lots of ways to be involved, every donation is important whether it's your time, maybe giving an hour on a stall at the Christmas Bazaar, baking cakes/biscuits for cake sales, donations for raffles or offers of skills.

Being involved in Holy Trinity School PTFA is a great way of getting to know parents in your class and across the various year groups.
