Key Stage 2 (Years 3 to 6) Equipment List

To prepare for September 2020, and in line with many other schools, parents / carers of Key Stage Two children (those who will be in Years 3 to 6) are asked to provide the following equipment for their children for the next academic year. However, we ask that you take particular note of the details below as some of these items have changed from previous years and those stated are the only permissible items to be brought into school.

- **Small** named pencil case (if too big, there will not be enough room for it on your child's table and in this instance please do not be offended if you are asked to change it)
- 12 coloured pencils (maximum number)
- 2 HB pencils
- Rubber
- Pencil sharpener (plain, small)
- 2 Handwriting pens with **black ink**
- 30cm. ruler
- Pritt stick
- 2 black whiteboard pens (dry wipe) and whiteboard eraser
- Children's stainless steel safety scissors
- 1 old shirt for Art
- A selection of highlighters (maximum 2 – either yellow, green, blue or pink)
- Please note, the school can no longer subsidise the purchase of the KS2 personal organisers and therefore pupils will also require an A5 academic week-to-view diary/organiser (must include printed 2020-21 dates)
- Protractor (*for Year 5 and Year 6 pupils only*)

Choosing and providing their own equipment helps KS2 children to take responsibility for and to value their belongings, each of which must be named. Please also note that pencil cases will remain in school.
