Cool Milk

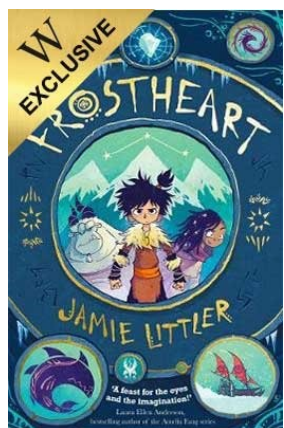
