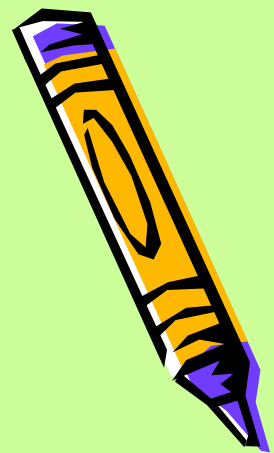
# Expectations

- Have fun and enjoy learning!

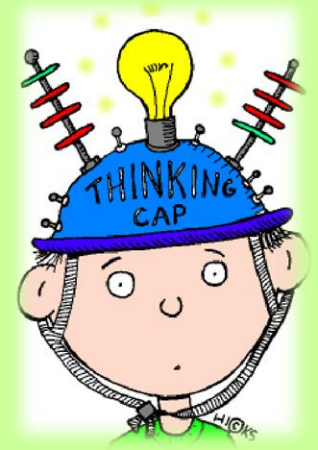

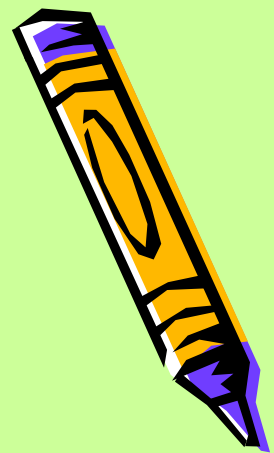
- WALT - We Are Learning To

- Marble - given as a class reward system, once the jar is full, then they are rewarded with a class treat.





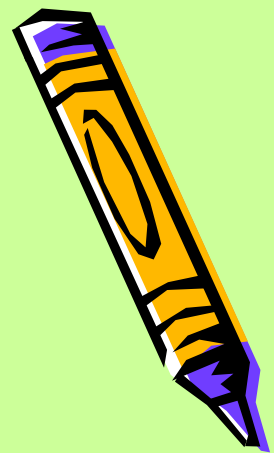
# Homework

# Talk for Writing™

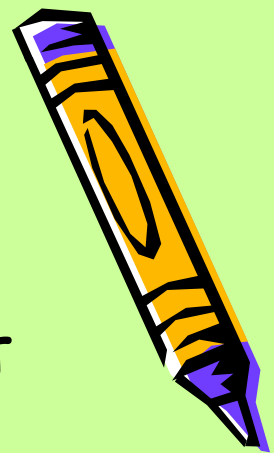


- GLP wide focus
- School Improvement Plan priority
- Focussing on the power of talk around pieces of writing
- Also focusing on writing styles of authors that the children attempt to replicate through the **imitate**, **innovate** and **invent** model
- Requires support from parents through reading and being questioned on their reading
- Data shows, nationally, children's **READING** has a direct correlation to the quality of children's **WRITING**





# Assessment



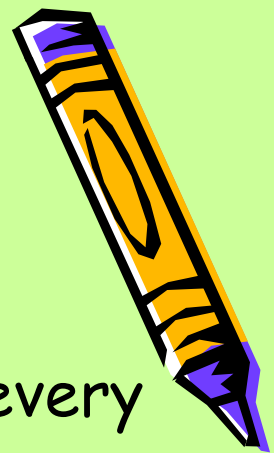
- Teacher assessment is ongoing throughout the year.
- We track the children using age related expectations in **ALL** subjects.
- NFER assessments at the end of the year to confirm teacher assessment judgements.

## Year 4 Multiplication Check

- An **online test** for pupils in Year 4. In June 2020, every school will be required to take part in the check.
- Pupils are asked to answer **25 questions** on times tables **up to  $12 \times 12$** .
- Overall the test should last no more than **five minutes**.
- We are using the term 'check', rather than 'test', at school.
- Using TT Rockstars regularly at home will support your child's learning.

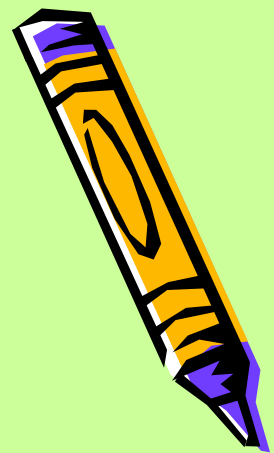

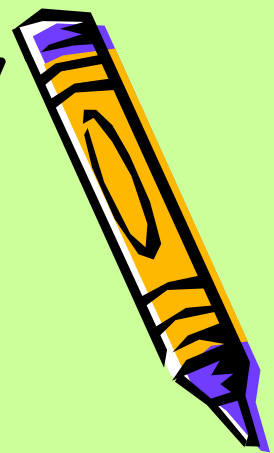

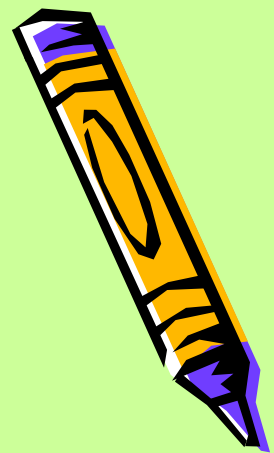
