Talk for Writing™

- ❖ GLP wide focus and School Improvement Plan priority
- ❖ Focuses on the power of talk around pieces of writing
- ❖ Also focuses on writing styles of authors that the children attempt to replicate through the **imitate**, **innovate** and **invent** model
- ❖ Requires support from parents through reading and being questioned on their reading
- ❖ Data shows, nationally, children's **READING** has a direct correlation to the quality of children's **WRITING**
