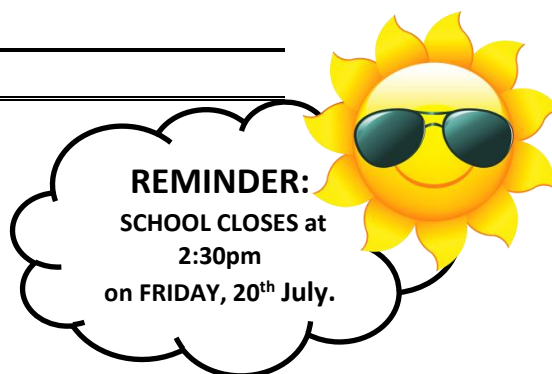
SCHOOL NEWS

Lymm Festival / Open Gardens Event- Sunday, 1st July

I would like to say a huge thank you to all of the parents who have donated, plants, pots, compost, trees, pine cones, etc for the project. Another big thank you goes to those of you who have given up your time to plant, weed, dig, build, paint or provide resources for the event! We are very grateful to our school community for your immense support. Our grounds are blooming and we will proudly share them with villagers who have purchased tickets and come along on Sunday. (Tickets can also be bought at the entrance.) Our PTA will be serving cream teas and Prosecco and St Mary's Pre-School will have soft drinks and biscuits stall.

The **Mayoress** is due at around 1pm to unveil our beautiful story seat, in memory of our late Chair of Governors, Sheila Woodyatt. Our School Council organised a fundraising event in order to purchase the story seat; we are very grateful to them for their efforts.

School Building Modernisation

For some time now we have looked at how we could improve upon the internal structure of our 1970s building, in particular the classrooms where space is minimal. Having spent months researching this and considering ways to find funding, we have found the ideal solution. Our aim is to have modern classrooms where careful storage will free up floor space, allowing greater space for the children to move around the class and better flexibility in terms of classroom layout.

With this in mind, we have some extensive work planned for during the summer break to modernise our school and improve upon the open plan teaching spaces. Classes 1, 2, 3 and 4 will be remodelled to give each class greater privacy and reduce the chance of noise disruption from one class to another. By re-designing the spaces, we will make the classrooms more conducive to teaching and learning, while still retaining the friendly inclusive nature of our school.

As a result of renting out the mobile classroom to the pre-school we have managed to generate some income for the school, we have saved this money to improve upon our own classrooms. Our PTA have kindly agreed to invest in this project as they recognise the positive impact that it will have on the teaching and learning. We have also managed to secure some funding from the local authority's 'Devolved Formula Capital' which is ring-fenced for building projects. Therefore, despite our budget still being tight, we have managed to gather enough money to complete the project this summer. I hope to have plans ready to display at the summer fair or the KS2 show for parents to look at.
