A termly inquiry based learning grid will also be available on the website from Monday in the event of closure this will also be able to guide pupils home learning.

## PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT

Please remember that if children are using the play equipment before and after school, parents/carers are responsible in making sure they are using it safely. The rules that the children devised are: only a maximum of 3 children from Rosemullion and Praa Sands class or a maximum of 2 children from Church Cove and Poldhu class at one time. The children need to remain seated while on the swing. The swing is to swing no higher than the wall and children are not to hold onto the front of the swing and be taken up into the air. We have also spoken to the children about only climbing within their height and where they feel safe. They decided that no one is to sit or stand on the top bars. If we feel that the equipment is not being used safely before and after school we will have to ask you to stop using it.
