

Pupil Premium - Report to parents
April 2014- April 2015

Pupil Premium was introduced in April 2011 and the funding is allocated each financial year to children who: have free school meals; had free school meals in the last 6 years; are from 'Service Families'; are adopted; or are in care. The schools can decide how the funds are used.

At Lostwithiel School we try to ensure that teaching and learning opportunities meet the needs of all the children to help them make or exceed expected progress.

The school has 35 children who currently qualify for Pupil Premium funding. Of these, there are ten children who are also on the SEN Support Register. Pupil Premium children are monitored by their class teacher and the Pupil Premium Coordinator. Children's progress is discussed with the relevant parents.

Our PP provision includes additional one-to-one tuition and small group tuition; these are provided by the class teacher or a teaching assistant (under the guidance of the class teacher) during school times and also, sometimes, after school hours. The funds have enabled teachers to focus on PP children in lessons by providing extra teaching assistant support in the classroom.

The funds have enabled the school to improve facilities, for example, the purchase of some more ipads, more library books (which were chosen by some PP children),

class reading books, and Maths resources. The PP funding has enabled PP children to participate in class educational visits at a reduced rate. Sports kits have been subsidised to allow PP to participate fully in the life of the school. Funding has enabled some PP children to participate in other learning events which they would otherwise have missed. The PP funding has been targeted to allow PP children to broaden and deepen their life experiences throughout the year at school.
