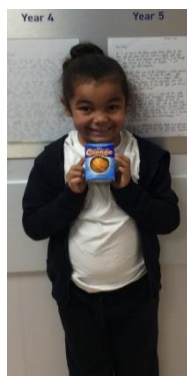
Easter Egg Appeal
