



## Chair of Governors Update July 2017

Dear Parents and Carers

I am delighted to give you all an update on behalf of the Southway Junior School Governing Body. We have had another very successful year.

For the first time in the school's history I am delighted to say we now have a waiting list for children wishing to join the school and we are officially oversubscribed.

### SATS Results

We have now completed our second year of teaching the new curriculum and I am delighted to confirm that our provisional SATS results continue to show an overall upward trend, with both Reading, Writing, GPS (Grammar Punctuation and Spelling) and Reading Writing & Maths combined all showing marked improvements. Our writing results were slightly lower and we have already started planning to address this area.

### Local Authority Visit Report

Recently we received a visit from the Local Authority Education team where they interviewed the Governing Body and Headteacher. The focus was firmly on the quality of Leadership and Management. The result of the meeting was extremely positive and they remarked that the local authority would support the school in self evaluating as 'outstanding' in leadership and management, as judged against current Ofsted criteria. Whilst having this external review was insightful and welcome we will continue to strive to make the entire school outstanding in all areas as judged by Ofsted.

### Investment in School Fabric and Premises

Our new Premises Manager Gareth Kirby has, I am sure you will all be aware, been busy ensuring the school premises continue to be improved. We are delighted that we have opened the pool this year and continue to fund improvements within school despite the very difficult financial constraints we find ourselves with.

We have agreed to relocate the ICT suite to the Music Room and continue with our carpet replacement plans, now moving into the Year 5 classrooms. Added to this we will be decorating all year 3 classrooms too.

Over the last 4 years we have managed to spend £107,500 on improving the school due to very careful financial planning and by raising funds from outside school means.
