Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 6 PGL Visit 2020

I am writing regarding our year 6 residential at PGL in September. We understand that there is still some uncertainty about when and how restrictions on school travel will be lifted and we hope that this email will provide some guidance for you as parents/carers.

As things currently stand, we are expecting that the PGL trip will still be going ahead. We are of course following government advice closely and we will keep this situation under review. Like schools and many other businesses, PGL has started to carefully consider how to keep children and staff safe. Their plans and risk assessments can be found on their website and are regularly updated in line with government advice.

The full payment is now due as we have to pay the remaining balance and confirm our final numbers with PGL. This is a significant amount of money and I know that many of you are concerned about what will happen to the money you've paid if the visit is cancelled. If you make the decision not to send your child and make no further payments, you will lose the payments you have made. However, if you make the final payment and the PGL Centre then cancel the visit due to government guidance, your money will be refunded.

I understand that this is a difficult time and none of us know how and when restrictions will be lifted. However, this is such a fantastic experience for the children at the start of year 6 and we would like to go ahead as long as it is safe to do so.
