Timetable

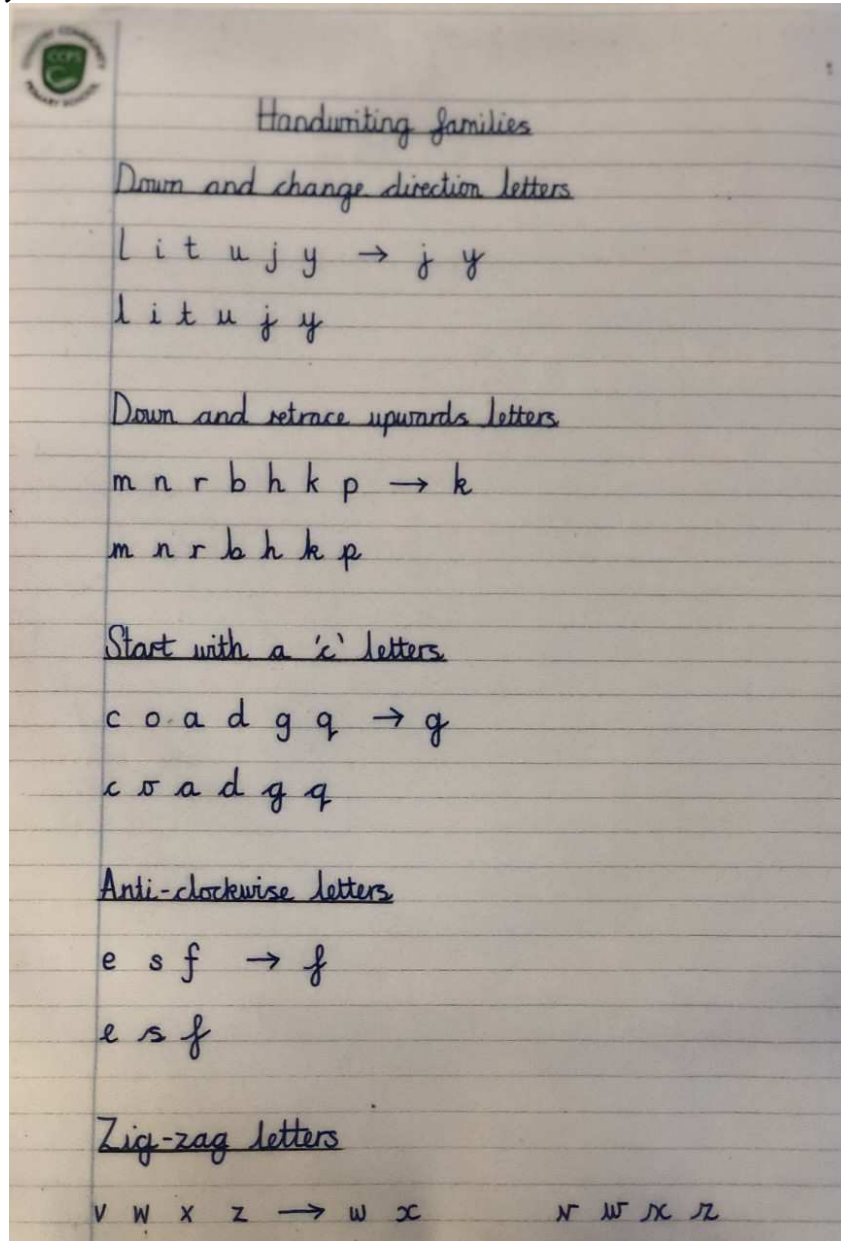
A typical day may look like this:

8.45am – 9:15am Spellings	Follow Google Classroom instructions set by teachers. If you finish within half an hour, go on Spellzone for the rest of your time.
9:15am – 9:30am Handwriting	Refer to the handwriting policy below and use to practise. Choose 5 words from your year group's common exception words for your child to write and practise their handwriting.
9:30am - 10am Reading	Reading aloud and discussion of books. 15 minutes of silent reading (Year 5 and Year 6). Fill in online reading record accessible on Google Classroom. Year 3 & 4 – parent and child complete reading record together. Year 5 & 6 – children complete reading record independently.
10am - 10.45am Writing	Follow Google Classroom instructions set by teachers. Remember neat handwriting if you are writing it out rather than writing on Google Docs. The children must still use punctuation even if they are typing their work.
10.45am - 11am	Break and healthy snack
11am – 11:15am Times Tables/ number skills	Times Table Rockstars: https://trockstars.com/ Numbots: https://trockstars.com/ Hit the Button: https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button
11:15am - 12 noon Maths	Follow Google Classroom instructions set by teachers. More maths activities can be found by following these links: https://classroom.thenational.academy/year-groups https://login.mathletics.com/
12noon - 1pm	Lunch
1pm - 2pm Home learning menu	Select one of the tasks from your Home Learning grid to complete. We recommend 2 each week.
2pm - 3pm Foundation subjects	Use BBC Bitesize to choose a task each day. You can share with your teacher on Google Classroom. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/levels/zbr9wmn Don't forget to do some PE! Joe Wicks is continuing PE with Joe.
