Sports Funding - Information for Parents 2018-19

The Government has made available additional funds to all primary schools for 2018-19. This money must be spent on improving the provision of PE and sport for the benefit of pupils registered at that school so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles.

The funding for 2018-19 is £16,650. Governors have agreed that at Swannington CE Primary School, the Sports Funding will be allocated in the following ways:

<p>NWLSSP</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Targeted sports coaching either after school, during lunchtime or in the morning once a week. This will be free to parents and children will have the opportunity to take part in a six-week session. Training for all teaching staff through team teaching with an experienced sports coach who attends for a morning or an afternoon once a week, including assessment of PE. Participation in the local Sports Partnership, including sporting events and continuing professional development for teaching staff. 	<p>£5500 + £5 per pupil</p> <p>£350</p>	<p>We aim to encourage children to take part in extra physical activity and to support children to participate confidently in local competitions and other sports events.</p> <p>Teachers are skilled at delivering PE, however we believe that skills can be further enhanced in certain areas, including assessment of PE. Children benefit from having PE sessions delivered by an experienced sports coach over the year.</p> <p>Ongoing participation in a wide variety of sporting activities, including the opportunity to take part in competitions.</p> <p>It will also include the training of Lunchtime Play Coach Leaders, in Years 5 and 6, who will then champion PE activities for other children in the school.</p> <p>'Happy Lunchtimes', a Wellbeing Education course via SSP training for Lunchtime Supervisors games to increase physical activity amongst pupils at lunchtimes and contribute towards pupils' mental health and well-being too.</p>
