

Maths

This term we will be focusing on Place Value and Number bonds using lots of concrete apparatus to support understanding. We will also look at addition and subtraction and how to use these to solve mastery problems.

English

We will start the term with lots of activities to promote talk and descriptive language. Our writing will be based on our topic and traditional tales. We will use role play and discussion to support children in creating their own stories. We will also look to develop handwriting skills and punctuation.

All about me and Once Upon a Time

PE

We will focus on teamwork and cooperation. Children will use bean bags and balls to develop hand/eye co-ordination and use games to strengthen their balance.

Topic

We will start the term learning about ourselves and exploring the history of fairy tales. Later in the Autumn term we will learn about Guy Fawkes and the Gunpowder plot whilst exploring the Monarchy at that time.

Personal Development

Children will be taking part in group discussions, circle time and activities to help them develop strong friendships and a sense of belonging.

Computing

Children will be developing confidence in accessing computers, improving keyboard skills and using IT to support their numeracy and literacy skills. We will use laptops during Art and DT when looking at Rangoli Patterns.

Science

Children will learn about their bodies and growth. They will find out how the body works, their organs and senses. We will investigate how their eyes work, how we look after our teeth and about nutrition. Later in the term we will look at plants, how they grow and the important of local wildlife and flora and fauna.

Art and Design Technology

We will start the term looking at portraits using a range of media and linking our work to PSHE. We will then create Woodland creatures using drawing and materials which will link to our fairy tale writing. This will include tree rubbings and using natural resources from our local environment.

RE

This term we will be learning about what it means to be a Christian, both in our School and the British Community. We will compare these to the Jewish and Muslim faiths.

Music

This term children will be using different instruments and exploring Music that could be heard in a fairytale Woodland.
