Car Parking

Further to repeated requests in previous newsletters, we find ourselves again having to write to you expressing our concerns about the possibility of an accident outside school at the beginning and the end of the school day. We have daily instances of dangerous parking, children being dropped off in the middle of the road, and inconsiderate parking with cars blocking driveways. We regularly receive complaints from residents who can't access or leave their driveways due to vehicles blocking their property!

Parking is available in the car park at the bottom of the hill, if you have to use St Paul's Drive for any reason, can we suggest that you drive up the hill and continue round onto Child's Road and out onto Batley Road via Pacaholme Road, this avoids blocking the road with two way traffic causing tail backs and disruption.

Can we also remind parents that the top school car park is for **staff and deliveries only**. Parents are asked not to use this as a drop off point or walk through the car park with children as this is a health and safety risk.

I know that the vast majority of you always park appropriately and with consideration for others, and share our frustration and concerns. If you witness any actions outside school that concern you, please can I ask that you report it to the police using the 101 number.
