Dear Parents/Carers

As I mentioned at the recent Year 6 SATs meeting, I am intending to run voluntary 'booster classes' before school in the run up to SATs. This is to either:

- provide extra support and practise for any Year 6 children who feel they may be struggling with certain aspects of Maths
- OR**
- to extend and build on work covered in class so that these children can have their attainment pushed that little bit further.

There will be two groups per week: Group A is for children who need extra support because they are currently working below age-related expectations and Group B is for children who are a little more confident and would like to practise some tougher questions in order to achieve an even stronger score in the SATs. It has already been explained to the children that they would only be expected to attend one of these groups, depending on the personal target that has been set for them.

Group A: Tuesday mornings, commencing 27th February. (The first week back).

Group B: Thursday mornings, commencing 8th March. (The second week back).

Both groups will start at **8.00am** and will run for 30 mins – giving the children a 15 minute break before 'main school' starts.

Please note that this is not a breakfast club, so food will not be provided.

I would be grateful if you could sign the slip below and return it to school by Friday 16th February to indicate whether or not your child is able to attend the booster classes.
