FSM Entitlements

If you think you are entitled to Free School Meals, please collect a form from the school office. The number of children eligible for Free School Meals affects the funding the school receives from the government, and we want to ensure that St Paul's receives its full entitlement as our pupils will benefit from this. You should do this even if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or 2 and in receipt of Universal Infant Free School Meals, or even if you plan to provide your child with a packed lunch. Once your FSM entitlement is confirmed your child will be added permanently to the Pupil Premium List. Children who are Pupil Premium are eligible for additional help such as free milk, two school jumpers per year and financial assistance on Educational Visits.
