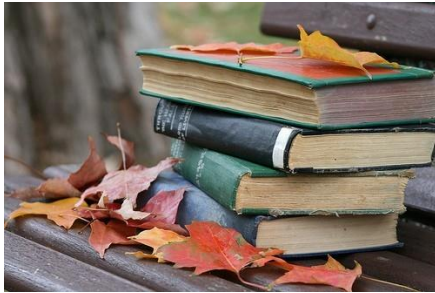

Class 3 – Orien in the Dark & Greek Myths

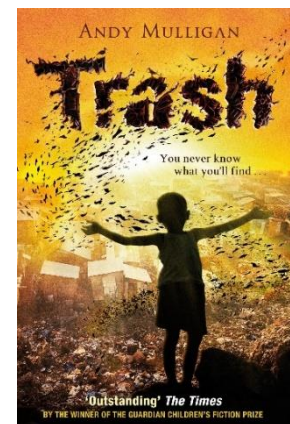
