Children in Years 5 and 6 Christmas Party Arrangements – 17th December 2015

We have tried a number of different approaches in the last few years to try and reduce waste on the Christmas Party days, all with varying degrees of success. This year we have arranged for the children to have a buffet lunch which will be prepared by ISS who are our school meal providers.

On party day your child will have a mid-morning snack. This is so that they can wait a little longer for their lunch. They will be able to choose a piece of flapjack, a muffin or a cookie. Then when the normal lunchtime service has finished they will have a buffet lunch. The menu is as follows:
