What will I learn?

- How children are taught to blend sounds together to read words
- How to recognise and match sounds (phonemes)
- How to demonstrate understanding of how phonemes are written to help with spelling
- Recognise strategies to help the children tackle words that are not phonetically regular
- Find out more about books they can share with their child
- Make and use activities to support children's learning

Who is it for?

This course is for all parents/carers who would like to support their child's language development, but who aren't sure how to go about it.

It's a joint class and parents are asked to participate alongside their child (ren).

The course aims to:

- Introduce parents to the way their children are taught to use phonics at school in reading and spelling.
- Introduce parents to games and activities that will make phonics fun.
- Provide parents with information and advice about children's reading development

When will it be?

Wednesday mornings from 16th September for 6 weeks (last session Wednesday 21st October)

Where will it take place?

United Kingdom classroom (middle room of the KS1 building)

What do I need to bring with me?

- You are not required to bring anything with you to the course.
