Management of Asthma Policy

Locking Primary School recognizes that asthma is a widespread and serious but controllable condition affecting many children and adults.

Locking Primary School encourages and helps children and staff to participate fully in all aspects of school life and will work in partnership with parents, Governors and health professionals to support this.

Locking Primary School recognizes that immediate access to inhalers is vital. Salbutamol inhalers are now kept on school premises for use in emergencies. Parental consent will have been given for emergency use.

Locking Primary School will do all it can to make sure that the school environment is favourable to children with asthma.

Locking School will give opportunities to enable other children to understand asthma so that any stigmas attached to this chronic condition can be avoided.

Locking School will ensure that all staff have a clear understanding of how to recognize the signs of an asthma attack and what to do in the event of a child having an asthma attack.
