

### English

In English this term, we are going to be reading *Man on the Moon* by Simon Bartram. This is a lovely story about Bob, an astronaut who works on the moon.




We will be concentrating on using subordinating conjunctions to add extra information and using the progressive (continuous) form in present and past tense.

In guided reading, we will be looking at *The Darkest Dark*, a book written by astronaut Chris Hadfield.

In phonics we will be starting to learn our Phase 6 spelling rules.

### Maths

In maths this term, our focus is going to be multiplication, and division.



We will be working on recalling and using multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables, including recognising odd and even numbers.

In quick maths, we will be focusing on our addition and subtraction facts to 20 and our times tables in order to increase the children's speed when answering these questions.

As always there is a whole school focus on developing our children's reasoning and problem solving skills.

### Music, Art and DT



In art and DT, we are going to be creating bottle rockets and spaceship porthole pictures.

Our skills focus in music is The Orchestra.


### Topic

This term, we are going to be learning all about air travel and space travel! We will be looking at the history of both, learning more about the significance of Amelia Earhart, Neil Armstrong, Christina Koch and Tim Peake. We're also going to be looking at seasonal and daily weather patterns and hot and cold areas of the world.



### Science

This term, our science topic is forces. The children are going to be learning to explore and describe the movement of familiar things, know that pushes and pulls are examples of forces and recognise that when things speed up, slow down or change direction, a force is the cause.



### PSHE and RE

This term in PSHE, we will be thinking about "Dreams and Goals".

In RE, we will be learning about Judaism and Islam and thinking about what Jews and Muslims believe.



### PE

As a school we follow the "Real PE" scheme of work which focuses on building up core skills and applying them in games. On Thursdays, the children will have a PE session with Mrs Smith.
