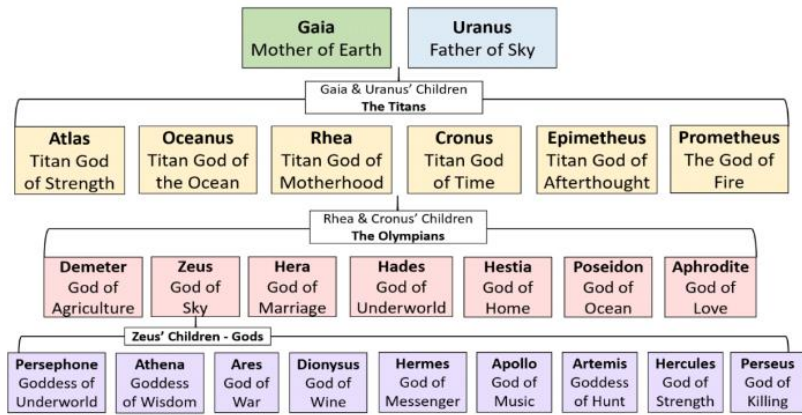


# Greek Gods and their family tree

Archimedes (m)	Famous mathematician, physicist, engineer, inventor and astronomer

## Vocabulary

Culture	The beliefs, customs, arts etc., of a particular society, group, place or time
Government	The system used for being in charge of a country
Democracy	Decisions about who should lead a country are made by the majority of its people
Architecture	The art or science of designing and creating building
Legacy	This or ideas that are passed down from one generation to another
Olympics	A series of athletic challenges that take place every four years.
Empire	A group of countries that are run by the government or another country.
Myth	A well known story, which was made up in the past to explain natural events.
Oligarchy	A type of government where the power is held by a few people.
Legacy	Ideas that are passed down from one generation to another.
Ancient	Belonging to the very distant past and no longer existent.
Amphitheatre	An open air venue used for performances and sport. Meaning a place to view from both sides.
